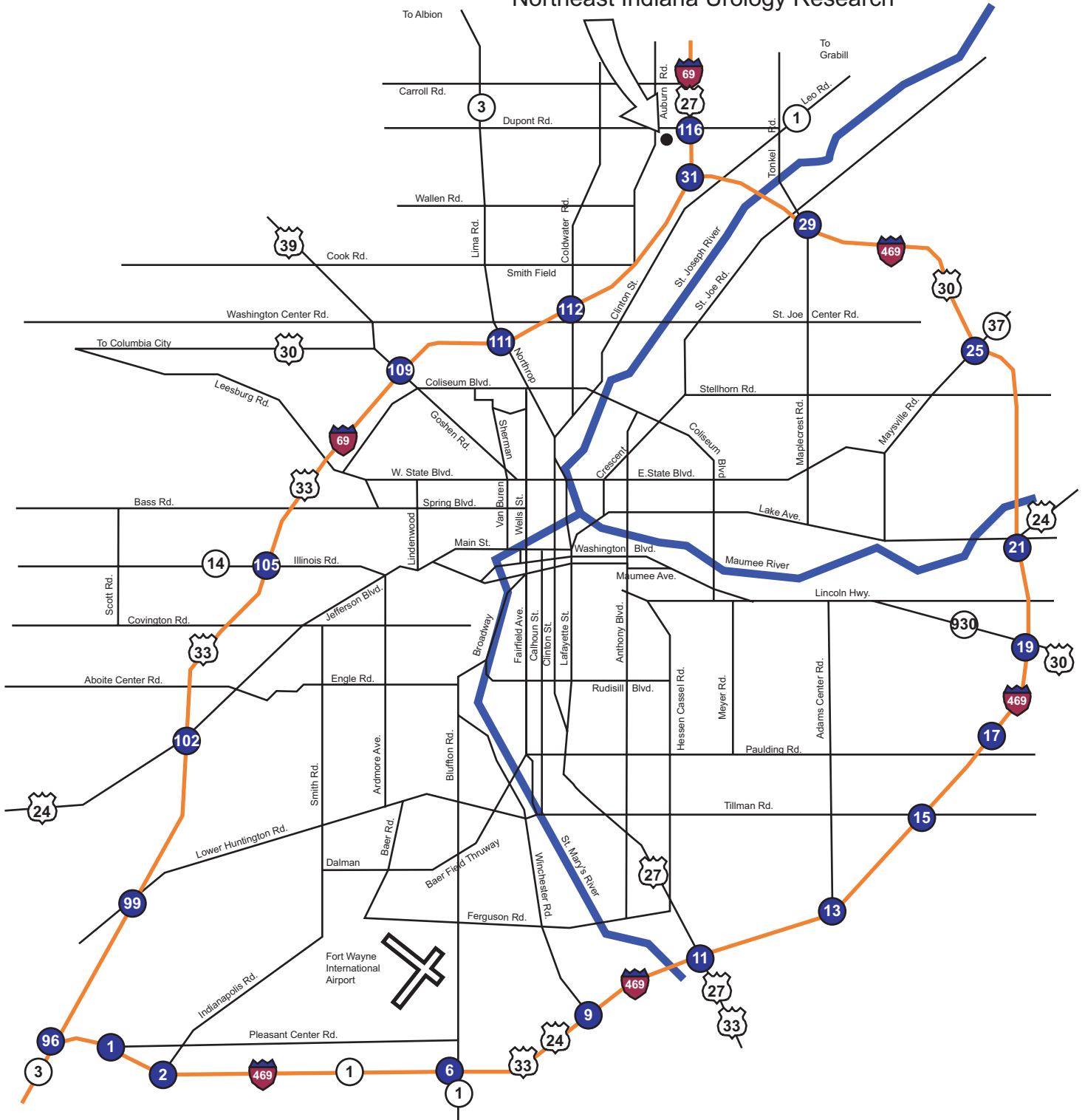


Fort Wayne Area Map
